### Virtual Learning Policy 2021-2022

All Leflore Legacy Academy scholars participating in total virtual learning (accessing instruction outside of the physical school building) are subject to this district policy that ensures instruction provided by and access granted to assigned teachers and that the virtual learning day includes the minimum amount of actual teaching as required by Miss. Code Ann. § 37-13-67.

Additionally, scholars and parents agree to:

- Signing a commitment letter that acknowledges receipt and acceptance of, and commitment to, this local board policy pertaining to virtual learning
- Criteria for scholars to participate and remain in virtual learning:
  - Scholars registration and enrollment must be complete.
  - Scholars must log into their Google classroom daily and on time unless an absence is reported to the school by the parent.
  - Scholars' camera must be turned on during the entire class period and for each class to be counted present for the class.
  - Scholars must complete and submit all class assignments according to teachers' expectations.
  - Interim assessments must be taken online during assigned times.
- Having reliable internet as a back-up to the school issued devices that will be distributed and must be returned upon request
- Using school issued chromebooks for class and school assignments only and returning upon request
- Attendance requirement: logged on for a minimum of 63% of the required school day to be counted present; present and on time each day unless absence is reported by the parent; assignments made up for any missed days
- Following the same code of conduct guidelines as in person scholars, including adhering to the school uniform policy
- Being present onsite for all state required assessments

Leflore Legacy Academy offers a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) for scholars with disabilities through virtual parent meetings, documenting progress toward IEP goals and communicating regularly through phone, email, mail, and social media.
